



The Roo Crew was founded in March 2020, just as the world was shutting down with COVID. Although launching a nonprofit in the midst of a Global pandemic created many roadblocks, our beginning in 2020 did allow us the opportunity to have something of a "soft opening" to our work, and it helped us to grow with careful intention.

Since that humble start, the word has spread! The Roo Crew is now serving families in all seven school districts in Spartanburg County. We have developed crucial partnerships with the administration in each district and have become a trusted partner in caring for Spartanburg families with children who have medical and/or educational obstacles. Those valued partnerships have extended to Spartanburg's professional community too, and we are so grateful for the skilled and experienced teachers, administrators, physicians, psychologists, speech therapists, and the many more professionals who have joined us in the complex but important work of caring for children with differing abilities.

Four years in, the Roo Crew's reach is now growing rapidly, and we are receiving referrals and welcoming new clients every week. But we learned a valuable lesson from those early days. The work of helping children leap medical and educational obstacles does not happen overnight.

The "soft opening" of 2020 taught us that perhaps our greatest gift to families is our commitment to walk beside them long-term. Every child and family has a story. And every child and family needs and deserves a crew to walk with them.
